

**MINUTES  
CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING  
JULY 6, 2015  
5:00 P.M.**

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CALL TO ORDER: Mayor W. James Grogan called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present were Mayor James Grogan, Councilmember Mike Sosebee, Councilmember Jason Power, Councilmember Angie Smith, Councilmember Caleb Phillips, City Attorney Dana Miles, City Clerk Bonnie Warne, Public Works Director Gary Barr and Public Works Associate Russ Chambers.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE: Invocation and pledge was led by Caleb Phillips.

AGENDA: Motion to approve the agenda by: J. Power/M. Sosebee. Vote carried unanimously.

MINUTES: Motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held June 1, 2015 and the called meeting work session held June 15, 2015 by: A. Smith/C. Phillips. Vote carried unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Document Purge of Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Files: Motion to approve the annual document purge by: M. Sosebee/J. Power. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

Stonewall \$2000 Sewer Tap Rebate for 8 Lots: Mayor Grogan informed Council of a Real Estate Contract done in 2007 of a \$2000 rebate on the sewer taps purchased to pay toward the purchase of a 3.2 acre lot by Memory Lane in Stonewall Subdivision. There are 8 sewer taps purchased for a rebate of \$2000 each (\$16,000) per the contract. Motion to approve payment by: J. Power/A. Smith. Motion carried unanimously in favor.

Millage Rate for FY 2015-16: On May 4<sup>th</sup> Council voted to roll back millage rate to zero and not levy a city tax. The City of Dawsonville Official Millage Rate Certification for Tax Year 2015 was calculated at 10.86 with a rollback to zero.

Georgia Association of Business Tax Officials (GABTO) Training Oct. 12-13 at Unicoi : Bonnie & Nalita: Motion to approve Bonnie and Nalita to attend GABTO training by: M. Sosebee/A. Smith. Motion carried unanimously in favor.

Staff Reports: City Clerk Bonnie Warne informed Council that all the bank accounts are balanced through May 2015 and are in good standing. The Activity Around Town listed the new/closed businesses, licenses, permits and events.

Gary Barr, Public Works Director, reported that they had 10 leaks this month with 8.8" rain, and are working on 3 lift stations and repaired the spring pump. Aug 4<sup>th</sup> the bids for water lines on Academy Ave and painting water tanks will be opened with Chris Poje, Turnipseed Engineers. Russ is working on quotes for generator maintenance and filters.

Council/Mayor Reports: Mayor and Council commented on the great training classes they attended while at the annual convention in Savannah.


