



## Valentine Yogurt Cupcake Bites

Prep time: 10 minutes  
Makes 4 servings



1 container (6 oz.) fat free strawberry yogurt  
1/2 cup reduced fat whipped topping  
4 strawberries, cut in half

Place mini paper baking cup in each of 8 mini muffin cups. Spoon slightly less than 2 tablespoons of yogurt into each cup.

Top each with a small dollop of whipped topping. Cover with foil or plastic wrap. Freeze at least one hour. Top with strawberry before serving.



### PREVENTING FROZEN PIPES

As we prepare for freezing temperatures, remember to protect your pipes from freezing by following a few easy tips:

- ◆ Let a trickle of hot and cold water drip overnight
- ◆ Keep your thermostat at the same temperature both day and night; colder temps are at night when most tend to turn their thermostats down
- ◆ Open cabinet doors to allow heat to get to un-insulated pipes under sinks and appliances near exterior walls
