



Message from the Mayor

“You cannot bring about prosperity by discouraging thrift. You cannot strengthen the weak by weakening the strong. You cannot help the wage earner by pulling down the wage payer. You cannot further the brotherhood of man by encouraging class hatred . You cannot help the poor by destroying the rich. You cannot keep out of trouble by spending more than you earn. You cannot build character and courage by taking away man's initiative and independence. You cannot help permanently by doing for them what they could and should do for themselves.” These words were spoken by Abraham Lincoln over 200 years ago. They are as true today as they were then.

Our city and county were built on these principles. As a young boy growing up in Dawsonville, I knew I could count on friends and neighbors to watch over me. Today we have to form a committee to carry dinner to a sick, elderly person in need. Somewhere along the way we have lost the ability to care about our neighbors on a personal basis. When I left my house on Highway 9 N., I knew I had to be on my best behavior. If I wasn't, Mrs. Clara, Mrs Plenny, Mr. Pete and Bernice, my grandparents Herman and Monnie Grogan, the Stowers , Smiths, Harbens, Grace Parks, Mrs. Clista, Mrs. Bonnel Patterson and of course our high school principal, Mr. Herbert Robinson were all available for correction. Guess what? My parents were not offended that these people looked after me. My parents did the same for theirs. We were a community that held to the belief in God, country, and apple pie. I was taught to say, "yes sir and no sir, yes ma'am and no ma'am, to give my seat to those older than me, respect my elders, go to church regularly, work hard, save for a rainy day, honor my father and mother, obey those in authority, and live by the "Golden Rule".

Some would call that old fashion, but I say it's what made this community what it is today and I still believe in those ideals.
