

# Environmental Noise Survey

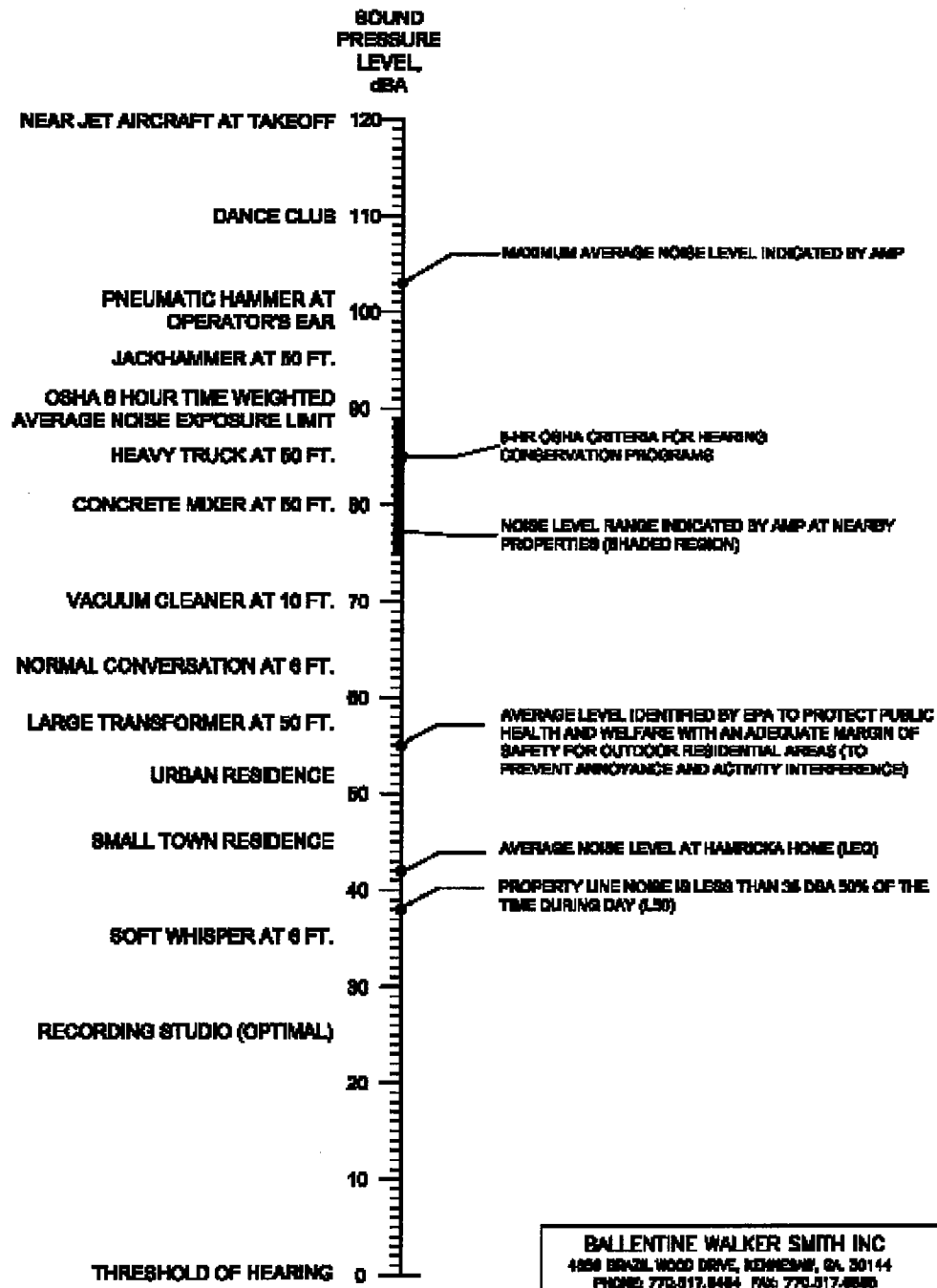
Conducted at a "representative" facility under various driving conditions, configurations, car types and vehicle speeds to obtain real world data

Adjustments can be made for attenuation effects cited above.

The advantage of this method is that the source data is based upon reality and not assumption.

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TITLE: SOUND NOMOGRAM INDICATING TYPICAL LEVELS OF VARIOUS SOURCES

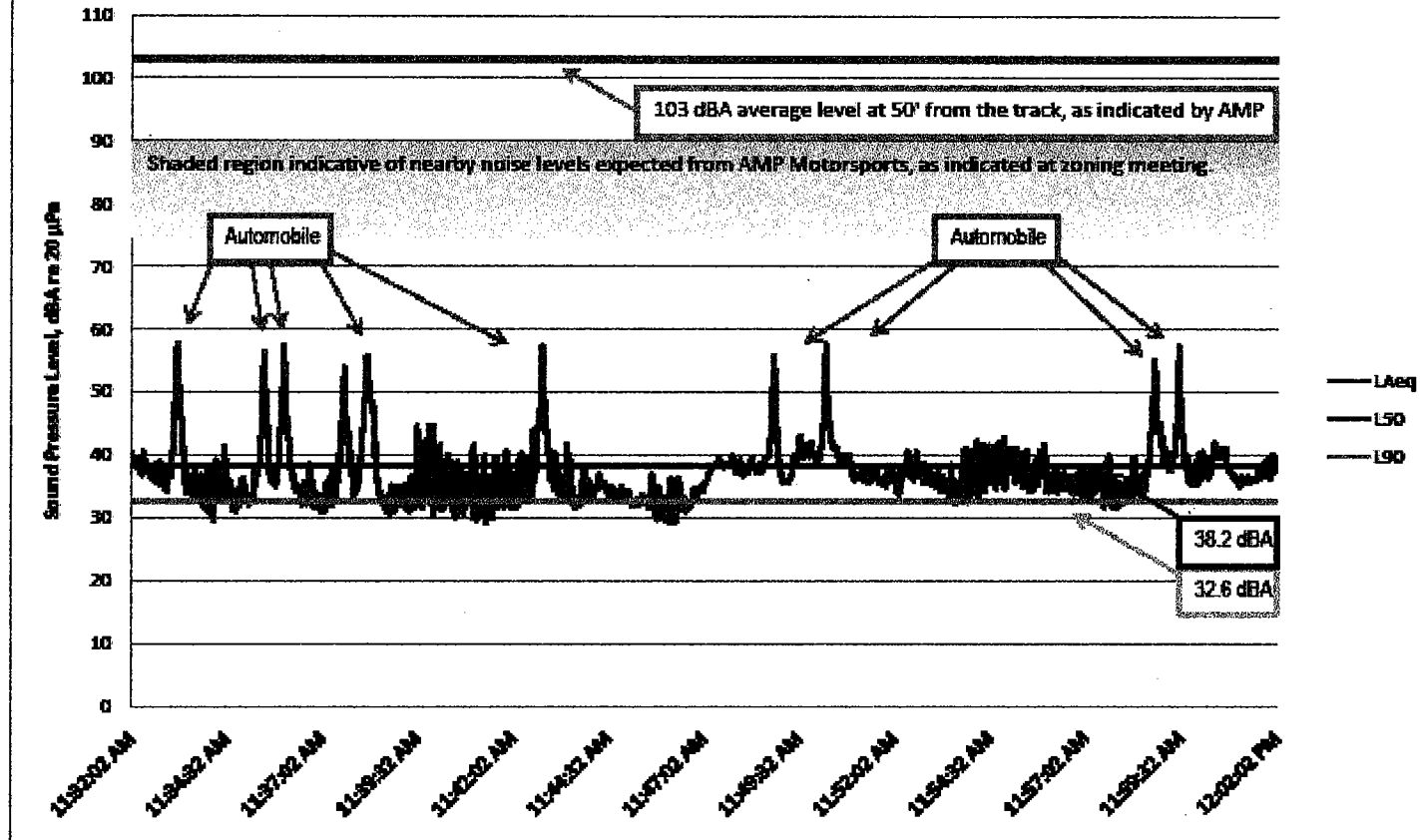
# Hamryka Background Sound Survey

On February 10, 2009 Ballantine Walker Smith, Inc. Collected Actual Background Levels on the Hamryka Property

Overall Sound Levels Are Below 38 dBA Over 50% of the Day

Average Sound Level at the Hamryka Home is 42 dBA

(11:32-12:02, 2-10-09)**



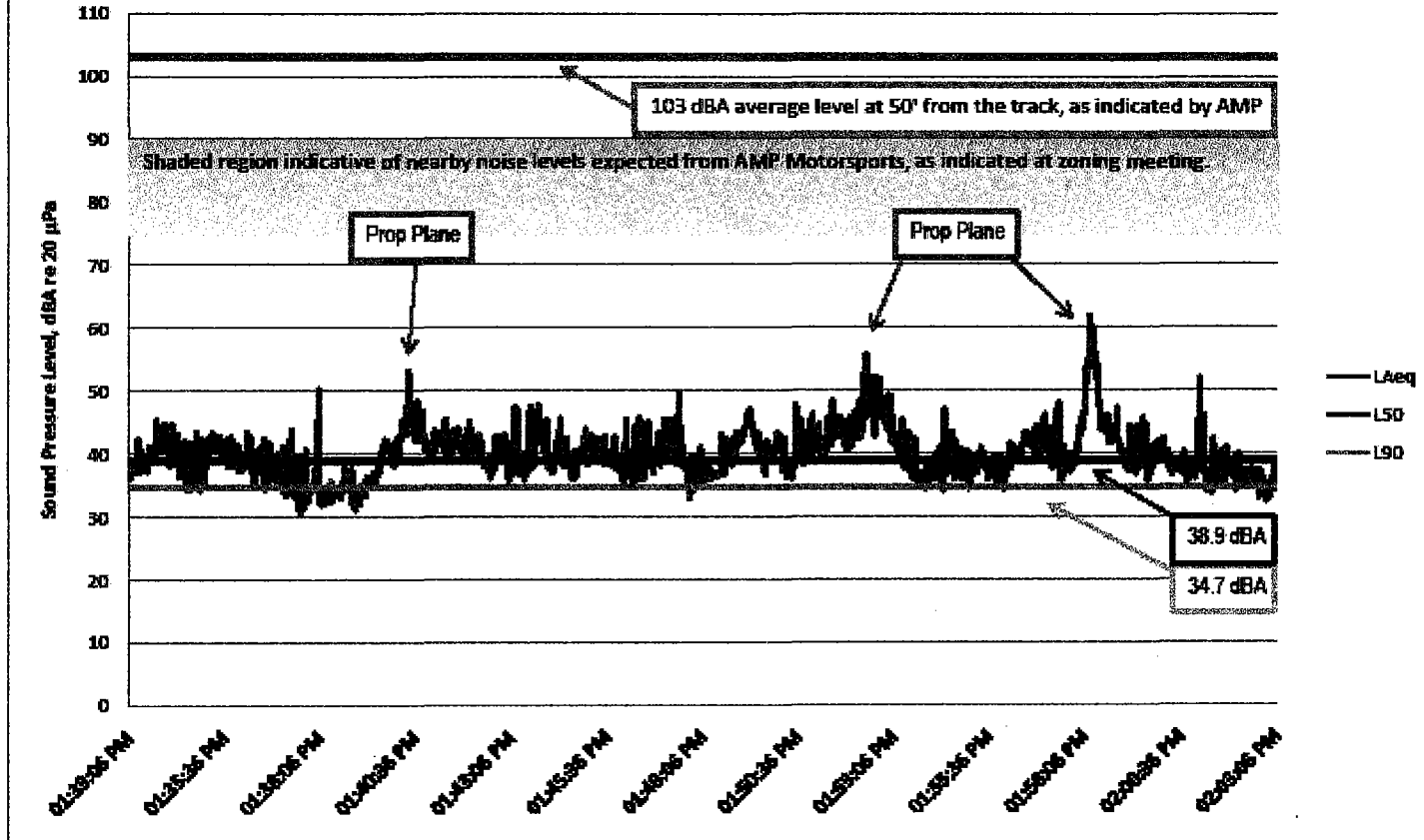
# Noise Pollution

As Indicated by Mr. Porter, Noise  
Would be Regulated at 103 dB at  
50 feet from the Track

Even with Berms, Average Noise  
Levels at the Property Line Will  
Increase to 75 – 90 dBA

Seven Days a Week, 365 Days a  
Year

# Impact on Hamrykas' Business

At the Barn, There Will Be a  
MINIMUM of a 35 dBA Increase in  
Noise Levels

A 10 dBA Increase is Considered  
Twice as Loud

Hamryka Home is 42 dBA
