I _____ (print name) **AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. The Farmers Market will be open for our farmers and customers May 1 through October 30, Tuesdays and Thursdays, 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
2. The Farmers Market location will be in the back parking lot of the Dawsonville Municipal Complex.
3. Only agricultural items grown or produced in Dawson County or adjacent counties (Lumpkin, Hall, Forsyth, Cherokee, Pickens, Gilmer) can be sold.
4. All packaged foods (canned goods, baked goods, etc.) must be labeled with the maker/seller's name and contact information (address and/or phone number), and ALL ingredients must be listed on the label. This is specified by the Georgia Department of Agriculture and is aimed to protect buyers with allergies. NOTE: Allowable canned goods are Jams, Jellies and Honey. *Licensed processors who have completed the Better Process Control School can sell acid or acidified canned foods. The school is out of UGA and can be reached at: 706-542-2574. Their web site is: www.efsonline.uga.edu A copy of current *license is required to be turned in with the application.
5. All persons selling flowers or shrubs (except cut flowers) must have a current license issued by the Georgia Department of Agriculture 706-265-2442. A copy of current license is required with this application.
6. Farmers are responsible for bringing their own table, chair and tent (if preferred). Each permit covers one space not to exceed 10 feet in width and 10 feet in length. Farmers may sell from a truck no longer than ¾ ton size rather than setting up a table/tent space.
7. Farmers must display a copy of their current permit at their sales table area.
8. The seller will determine the price of their produce.
9. Produce will not be sold by weight unless the scale is certified by the Department of Agriculture.
10. Farmers must agree to leave the market space clean.
11. We urge you to keep the close parking spaces available for customers.
12. The City of Dawsonville and its employees, GRHOF and its volunteers will not be liable for any accidents or harm related to the activities of the Dawsonville Farmers Market.
