#### Message from the Mayor....

I hope everyone has been enjoying our interesting winter weather. We have had an enormous amount of rain in the city and in the area during the past few months. This has caused delays in the construction of Main Street Park and other projects going on around the city. Just to update you on the park, we are required to conduct roll tests, which must occur before the contractor can place asphalt on the gravel base that has been down since November. The gravel is so wet that the asphalt will not adhere properly and will crack and crumble if it is not dry underneath. We are working with the contractor to get other options so that we can get the park completed and move on with the playground and bathroom, as well as landscaping. This will hopefully allow citizens of the city and county to enjoy the park during the summer months. We also look forward to having it available during the Moonshine Festival and are considering other options for other events there.

Many other things are occurring in the city. We have a new trash service provider and they are doing a good job. We have many construction projects that being worked on in the city. These include the large development on Hwy 9 South. Also, we have a contractor who has restarted the Crown Point subdivision off Burt Creek Road. Additionally, the Creekstone development, as well as the development on Maple Street, are continuing to build homes.

Our Planning Commission heard from two other developers this week (Feb 11th) concerning developments, one being a 55+ community located off Hwy 53 West just past Howser Mill Road.

The city is growing, and we want to work with you as our citizens to provide you information and ensure that you know what's happening here. We are working to try to develop interest of new businesses to come into the city. The city continues to work on issues pertaining to traffic in the downtown area to include our approaches into the city, to provide a safe area for our students attending school as well as our citizens getting in and out of their residences and subdivisions. Please join us as we work to accomplish this for our community.

Contact myself or any members of the City Council at any time and ask questions about what's going on and we will be glad to provide you that information. The city staff is here to serve the citizens of the city and we encourage you to ask questions and become better informed.
