### A message from your City Manager...

Happy Valentine's Day from the City of Dawsonville!

Good ole Georgia weather continued to be a challenge, with February cold and wet, as well as February looks like spring weather, from temperatures in the high teens and twenties with snow/sleet to temperatures in the upper 60's. There is still winter weather to come, but the jonquils and daffodils are starting to bloom reminding us that spring is right around the corner.

This month, we kicked off our work on the Comprehensive Plan, one of the most important planning documents that we prepare, with 16 of 25 invited to sit on the steering committee showing up for a great first meeting. This document is done every five years. It addresses quality of life maintenance and improvement. All stakeholders should give input to develop a vision that clearly describes the future of the community and that is shared by all. The Comprehensive Plan should ensure private property rights are protected, economic development is encouraged and supported, and more. Our next meeting is scheduled for March 9th at 5:30 p.m. here at City Hall.

It is with great sadness that we report the death of our outstanding Planning & Zoning Director, Mr. Harmit Bedi. A true professional planner and great communicator passed away suddenly. He had joined our team in October, had proven his worth, and become a big part of our city family. Please keep his family in your prayers.

The contractors continued work on the telemetry portion of our upgraded water meter system. This change will enable us to locate leaks quickly and pass that information on to our customers. Staff continues work on the Winner's Circle in front of the Georgia Racing Hall of Fame, and is designing improvements to the front entrance. The space in our facility that most recently housed the Dawsonville Distillery is currently vacant. We are seeking other businesses that would like to lease this superb space. Our goal is to have a restaurant, perhaps a coffee shop, and another distillery in this space. If you are interested in this great business opportunity, please let us know.

We hosted the Chamber of Commerce Junior Leadership group for their annual mock City Council meeting. This role playing opportunity introduces students to city government and how it operates, as well as available careers. Staff continues working on various projects and preparing facilities for the upcoming spring season. We encourage you and yours to come out, utilize city facilities and get involved in your community.
