A message from your City Manager...

Fall is here, and winter and the holidays are just around the corner. There is a lot going on in the city. The Ghost Walk hosted by the GA Racing Hall of Fame has been cancelled, but plans to return next year. The Moonshine Festival is October 28th-29th, and the annual Christmas Tree Lighting, Parade, Jingle Market, Santa pictures, live entertainment, and food trucks is scheduled for November 18th. We are working with The Place to start an annual Christmas decoration contest this year. Please be on the lookout for how your residence, business, school, church, or subdivision entrance can participate. Cash prizes and gift bags will be offered to the winners.

Our Comprehensive Plan, a process we must go through every five years, is complete and has been approved by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs. TSW and City staff hosted a very successful Strategic Plan Kick-off Meeting on September 7th, with over 50 people in attendance. Our next meeting is November 2nd at 6 PM. The following is a partial list of what to expect in the coming months. The Dawson County Civitan Club donated \$10,000.00 to the city, which will be used to install shade over inclusive portions of the Main Street Park playground. Amicalola Electric Membership Corporation donated \$20,000.00 to the city for economic development. Our entry in the Good Shepherd Clinic Scarecrow Contest is Disco Scarecrows; please go to social media and vote/like it and share it. The pickleball courts and basketball court are nearing completion. We have started work on expanding and relocating the skate park. We hope to begin expansion of disc golf soon, thanks to the Board of Education allowing use of some of their property. A mural is underway on the back wall of the GA Racing Hall of Fame, funded in part by a \$500,000.00 grant they were awarded. An RFP will soon be awarded to conduct a historical survey of Dawsonville, paid for by a \$6,000.00 grant. Soon, work will start at City Hall on the space for Granddaddy Mimms Distillery and Brewery, space for a new restaurant, and renovation to the patio area outside.

Finally, with the delightful fall weather, we encourage everyone to get out and enjoy the city. Come enjoy the Moonshine Festival, use our walking trails, play a round of disc golf, use our fitness stations, or the skate park.


