A message from your City Manager...

October was a busy month, with gorgeous leaf colors and a most successful Moonshine Festival. Our disco scarecrow received second place in the annual Good Shepherd Clinic contest. We appreciate everyone who voted.

Even with the days getting shorter, project work continues. Work is almost finished on four new pickleball courts and a new basketball court. An enlarged pad has been poured for relocation and expansion of our skate park. We look forward to that project getting underway in early 2024. A shelter and restroom will be constructed on the site of the existing skate park. We are researching shade for portions of the inclusive playground that we hope to have in place before next spring.

Many thanks to Amicalola Electric Membership Corporation for a \$20,000.00 grant for economic development, which will go toward commercial kitchen equipment for the old distillery space. It will be developed into a new brewery/distillery in half the space and a restaurant in the front half. Work is starting on the buildout this month. We have finalized a redesign and upgrade of the patio area outside that space.

Our downtown strategic plan is underway, having already hosted two public meetings as we look to the future development of the recently purchased 17 acres that will connect to the historic downtown and the City Hall/Main Street Park/Farmers Market areas. This is funded in part by a grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission. Speaking of the Farmers Market, their last market day was in October, and they enjoyed a very successful season.

As Thanksgiving draws closer, I encourage everyone to take a break and reflect on all we have to be thankful for in our community. I am thankful for my Savior, my family, friends, community, and for the wonderful City personnel and elected leadership I work with every day.
