Since March 2012, I have had the pleasure of serving the wonderful citizens of this community as your Post 1 City Councilman. Our city is growing and changing. We have new businesses downtown. At City Hall, we will soon have two new businesses – Granddaddy Mimms Distillery and Brewery and a new restaurant will be opened by the owners of the Station House in Cumming. Adjacent to those two new businesses, soon the city will be renovating and upgrading the patio area with outdoor dining options, additional recreation and much more. Our unique Georgia Racing Hall of Fame and Dawsonville History Museum is currently making some great upgrades, including three new high tech racing simulators, a brand new 50's garage exhibit, and upgrades to their audio-visual system.

Main Street Park continues growing with the recent addition of four pickleball courts, an expanded skate park, and soon we will have an expansion of our popular disc golf course. The Farmers Market opens for the season every Saturday, starting on April 27th.
