CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Grogan called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present were Mayor W. James Grogan, Councilmember Angie Smith, Councilmember Caleb Phillips, Councilmember Jason Power, Councilmember Mike Sosebee, City Attorney Dana Miles, City Manager Bob Bolz, City Clerk Bonnie Warne and Public Works Manager Trampas Hansard.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE: Invocation and pledge was led by Mike Sosebee.

AGENDA: Motion to move agenda item #13 to #2A on agenda by: C. Phillips/M. Sosebee, carried unanimously. Motion to approve the amended agenda by: J. Power/M. Sosebee. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

MINUTES: Motion to approve the both sets of minutes: the regular meeting March 6, 2017 and the work session March 20, 2017 by: J. Power/M. Sosebee. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

PUBLIC HEARING:

ZA-2017-C7-00089: Atlanta Motorsports Park LLC has requested to amend/modify the existing zoning stipulations/conditions for TMP 070 049.001 located at 80 Joe Lane Cox Road AKA 20 Duck Thurmond Road; current zoning is CIR (Restricted Industrial) with stipulations.

Attorney Dana Miles presented the application and informed all that each side will have 10 minutes. There are approx. 76 people logged into attendance. The public hearing was unanimously opened by: J. Power/C. Phillips. Matthew Dominick spoke in favor for the applicant. Madonna Anderson and Helen Hamryka spoke in opposition. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

RFP 17-02: Bids for Water Meters, Resolution to Award Contract, and paid by a GEFA Loan: Motion to approve the bid of M&E Construction at \$465,396.76 and city manager to apply for the GEFA DWSRF Loan by: M. Sosebee/J. Power. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

RFP 17-03: Bids for Water System Improvements/Well Development, Resolution to Award Contract, and paid by GEFA DWSRF 14-008 Loan and SPLOST \$: Motion to approve the bid for Division One to Townley Construction Company at \$117,823.25 and Division Two to P. F. Moon and Company at \$682,000.00 by: C. Phillips/J. Power. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

Lease Agreement Renewal April 2017-March 2018: Rental House at 224 Flat Creek Dr.: Caleb Phillips recused. Motion to approve the lease agreement on the rental house for April 2017 thru March 2018 by: M. Sosebee/J. Power. Vote carried in favor 3-0-1 recused.

Resolution: GA Cities Week April 23-29, 2017: Mayor James Grogan read the resolution for GA Cities Week April 23-29, 2017 into the minutes.

<u>Special Event Permit with Alcohol: Bowen Arts Center</u>: Motion to approve permit by: J. Power M. Sosebee. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

REPORTS:

City Manager Bob Bolz updated the Council on the status of the ongoing projects in the City: 3 proposals were received on the airport consultant; 3 applicants were interviewed for the Planning Director and currently getting reference checks on; Justin Stewart was hired for the equipment operator; interviews done on 7 applicants for admin/grant position and currently doing reference checks on 4 of them; and we advertised for the position of treatment plant operator.

The City can now accept credit cards for General Fund. The only thing we do not accept credits for are the initial security deposit on new water accounts because the account is not set up yet.

City Clerk Bonnie Warne reported on the February 2017 financial report, stating that the bank statements are all balanced with no discrepancies, and that the L.O.S.T., S.P.L.O.S.T. VI revenue has increased, and the revenue and expenditures are mostly within budget.

Public Works Operations Manager, Trampas Hansard reported that the paving has started in Red Hawk Subdivision, that the engineering is done for Perimeter Rd and grass season has started.

Mayor Grogan stated that he attended a GMA 2-day training and learned a lot from the classes.
