

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
OCTOBER 20, 2014
5:30 P.M.**

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor W. James Grogan called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

ROLL CALL: Present were Mayor James Grogan, Councilmember Mike Sosebee, Councilmember Jason Power, Councilmember Angie Smith, Councilmember Chris Gaines, City Attorney Dana Miles, City Clerk Bonnie Warne and Trampas Hansard.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE: Invocation and pledge was led by Jason Power.

AGENDA: Mayor Grogan asked to amend the agenda for 4A Dawson County LMIG Application-Burt Creek Rd. Motion to approve the amended agenda by: M. Sosebee/J. Power. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

BUSINESS:

Chamber of Commerce Report by Christie Haynes: Christie Haynes spoke on the attractions of Dawsonville/Dawson County and the increase in revenue through advertising, tourism, and events.

City Commitment of Funds Letter on Recreational Trail: Motion to approve the letter for the Main Street Park Trail project at \$125,000 with a City commitment of \$25,000 in cash and in-kind work in the form of labor and equipment by: M. Sosebee/J. Power. Vote carried unanimously in favor. Exhibit "A"

Resolution on Recreational Trails Program: Mayor Grogan read the resolution into the record. Motion to approve the resolution by: C. Gaines/ A. Smith. Vote carried unanimously in favor. Exhibit "B"

Code Enforcement: Mayor Grogan and the Council discussed code enforcement and the many ordinances on the books that can be enforced and how to proceed with bringing issues back to code.

Dawson County LMIG Application-Burt Creek Rd.: Attorney Miles spoke on the letter received from Dawson County Attorney Joey Homans on paving Burt Creek Rd. Motion to approve Attorney Miles drafting a response that the City approves the County proceeding with the LMIG application on Burt Creek Rd with the following conditions: that this will not count against the City LMIG or 1 mile paving service delivery agreement by C. Gaines/ A. Smith. Vote carried unanimously in favor.

The annexation and rezoning application were heard together for same parcel. Motion to open the public hearing was unanimous in favor: J. Power/A. Smith with Chris Gaines recused. Attorney Dana Miles presented the applications. Joe Gaines spoke in opposition on spot annexation, Colleen Simrell and Brenda Schulz both spoke and Brenda read John Stegall's letter and Mr. Watson provided a letter in support of his annexation into the City which Mayor Grogan read. RESOLUTION

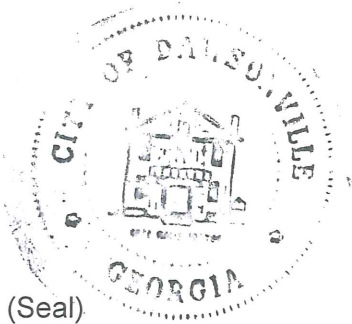
STATE OF GEORGIA

WHEREAS, at the called meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dawsonville, Georgia held on the 20th day of October, 2014 a motion was made and duly seconded that the City of Dawsonville shall submit an application for funding from the Georgia Department of Natural Resources' Recreational Trails Program to develop opportunities for the public good and the general welfare of the citizens of Dawsonville and the State of Georgia, and provide recreational and educational amenities to residents of the City by the proposed Main Street Park Trail Project, and

WHEREAS the City of Dawsonville further states that in the event the City of Dawsonville's application is recommended for funding by the Department of Natural Resources, City of Dawsonville certifies and assures that it has the ability and intention to finance 100 percent of the total project cost and be reimbursed for 80 percent of eligible costs by the Department of Natural Resources,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Dawsonville, Georgia that it shall submit an application for funding from the Georgia Department of Natural Resources' Recreational Trails Program, and that it shall, in the event that the application is recommended for funding, take action to assure that it will finance 100 percent of the total project cost and be reimbursed for 80 percent of eligible costs by the Department of Natural Resources.
