QUESTIONS/CLARIFICATIONS

1. Will all patching be done at a minimum of 7 feet wide to allow the use of a standard 7-foot-wide milling machine? **That is correct...that should accompany the quantities that were calculated also.**
2. All streets are to be edge milled 7 feet wide from the gutter line except for North Raymond parks street and the on-street parking for Tucker Ave, correct? If so, The City realizes that the final grade will be raised by 1.25" approximately vs existing grade? **This is correct. The subdivision streets are to be flush with existing gutter line. Only North Raymond Parks Street and Tucker Ave will be up 1.25 inches.**
3. Should manhole and water valve adjustments be included? If so, would the City add a pay item to cover this cost? **The City will provide risers to be installed during construction and cost should be included in the overall bid.**
4. If manhole and water valve adjustments are to be included, may risers be used? **The City will provide risers to be installed during construction.**
5. The detail regarding the first 400 feet of Rainhill Station drive shows 4" Patching and 1.25 (135 Lbs/SY) of topping and no milling. Would the City actually prefer milling in this section as well to keep the new grade the same as existing and flush with the gutter? **This area of Rainhill Station Drive has bad alligator cracking. The idea is to remove all of it down to 4" deep and only put back 3" approximately and then top it so the finished grade will be flush with the existing gutter.**
6. May advanced warning signage be placed on temporary tripod stands? **Yes temp tripods are acceptable.**
