However, often we take it for granted, especially when our local fire/EMS and law enforcement resources are so dedicated and responsible. I am asking everyone to please keep this in mind as they decide where to park. On streets owned by the city, our personnel can write citations. In most subdivisions, the HOA's have rules against parking in the streets. The bottom line is public safety. Please help keep you and your neighbors safe by paying close attention to where and how you park. It would be a tragedy to see lives lost or great damage or loss of property because of cars parked inappropriately or illegally. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
